MOVING ON WITH GOD Studies in the Book of Exodus

**Motto: 'I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of Egypt'
(Exodus 20: 2)**

- Feb.10 The Passover (Ex.12:21-28)**
The Christian life begins with a rescue due entirely to God's grace.
A repeated recollection of how He has redeemed us.
- Feb.17 Miraculous bread and water (Ex.16, 17:1-7)**
The Christian life is kept going by a daily trust in God's care.
A constant awareness of our utter dependence on God.
- Feb.24 The assembly at the rock (Ex.19)**
The Christian life can only flourish in the fellowship of God's church.
A commitment to regular meeting with Him among his people.
- Mar.2 The pillar of cloud and fire (Ex. 13:21f; see Numbers 9:17-23)**
The Christian life goes right only when it is under God's direction.
An equal readiness to serve Him here or anywhere else.
- Mar.9 The making of God's wonderful tent (Ex.35)**
The Christian life involves putting all we have at God's disposal.
A consecration of all our varied gifts to his service.
- Mar.16 The goal of the promised land (Ex.3:8)**
The Christian life makes sense only as a journey towards God's
heavenly country. A recognition that his great object is to bring us by
way of this life into the next.
